


BMS Applying to County for Development Permit Change

Landfills in the province of Alberta are sited, designed, constructed, operated and reclaimed so as to meet, as a minimum, the requirements specified in the Waste Control Regulation under the authority of section 36 of the Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act. This means that in order for a landfill to operate, it requires an Approval for its construction, operation, closure and post-closure activities.

BMS has an Approval permit from Alberta environment to build our landfill to a maximum waste elevation height of 740 metres above sea level, spanning both the northeast and southeast quarters of the section. Currently our landfill is built to a maximum height of 712 metres. In addition to our Approval permit from the province, we also have a development permit from Beaver County. However, due to a




Current Landfill Form

previous oversight, the current development permit with Beaver County is for 715 metres, not 740 metres. It is necessary for our growth to have the County's development permit align with our provincial permit. For this reason, BMS will be making an application to the County to change the development permit to match the provincial Approval.


The diagram above shows the current topography on our active landfill site. The drawing to the right shows what the landform would look like when the landfill is at capacity as per the provincial approval, spanning two quarters.

The two drawings below show the structure changes of the landfill from its current position to the planned final landscape shape. It shows that the overall shape will remain the same, just a slightly higher elevation.


