Large Item Program Starts in May

Our spring Large Item Program will be starting soon. Urban residents located within Beaver County can place their large items for collection on their front street the evening before their scheduled pick up. Rural residents can take their large items to their nearest transfer station as per the scheduled collection date. There is no charge for this program, however if disposing of fridges or freezers, there is a \$25 charge to have the Freon removed. If placing these items out for pick up, they will require a Freon-removal sticker that can be purchased at your local municipal office.

Residents are asked to use this program only for large items. Smaller items such as chairs and regular household garbage can be placed directly into the neighbourhood waste collection bin.
