

Tips For Winter Waste Collection

Picking up waste in the winter comes with some challenges for our collection drivers. In rural areas, accessing the bins sometimes is difficult after a large snowfall. Please ensure you keep your driveway and the area in front of the waste bin plowed and accessible. Our waste collection drivers thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Rural customers will be receiving a 2019 collection schedule shortly that identifies which week during the month our drivers will be in your area. If you ever require an additional pick up or if you believe your bin has been missed, please call our office at 780.663.2038 so we can help you out.

So what can you put in your waste collection bin? For both rural and urban bins, you can place bagged



household garbage into the bin. Other dry garbage, such as chairs or tables, should be cut down to no longer than 3 feet. Longer items cause problems for our compaction equipment. Please do not place items on top of the lids or beside the bin. If you have questions about what can be placed in your waste collection bin, please feel free to call our office.

Did You Know?

Beaver Municipal Solutions manages the recycling contract for several paper and cardboard bins located throughout the County. We also are piloting a program at the Lindbrook Transfer Station to provide service for the paper and cardboard bins. Staff are currently assessing this program to determine if we will roll it out at some of the other transfer stations in the future.

The success of a program such as this is proper placement of the materials for recycling and disposal. Styrofoam and plastic that often surrounds items for protection, need to be removed before cardboard is placed in the bin for recycling. Contamination in the recycle collection bins reduces the marketability and may even result in the product having no value at all.

The Lindbrook, Tofield and Viking Transfer Stations will be closing at 4:00 pm on Saturday, December 15, 2018 for our annual staff Christmas function. Please ensure you are onsite by 3:30 in order to have time to unload your garbage before the site closes. All sites will resume with the regular hours the following week.
